*Please Note: Schedule subject to change. No figure skating sessions on Saturday or Sundays. All skaters and all coaches must sign-in and pay at the front desk before stepping on the ice. *Coaches must have current liability insurance on file with management and pay a pro fee for each session on which they provide instruction. Skaters and coaches who get on the ice without signing in and paying will be asked to leave the ice. Persistent violators will be banned from sessions and charged with theft of services.*

SESSION GUIDELINES

For the benefit of our skaters, coaches, and parents, please observe the following guidelines so figure skating sessions can be a positive experience for everyone. Figure skating sessions are designed for figure skaters to learn advanced skills, train, and practice routines. **Skaters and coaches must sign in and pay at the front desk before stepping on the ice. All coaches must have current liability insurance on file with management and pay a pro fee for each session. Skaters and coaches who get on the ice without signing in and paying will be asked to leave the ice. Persistent violators will be banned from sessions and charged with theft of services.**

SESSION DEFINITIONS

- **Open Sessions** are used for Dance, Freestyle, Moves in the Field, and Learn to Skate USA Basic 4 or above. There are a variety of disciplines on this session that require your special awareness.
- **Freestyle/Dance Sessions** are used for Freestyle, Dance, Moves in the Field, and Learn to Skate USA Basic 4 or above.
- **Adult Sessions** are open to skaters aged 18 and up and used for Dance, Freestyle, Moves in the Field, and Learn to Skate USA Basic 4 or above. There are a variety of disciplines on this session that require your special awareness.

The management of Sertich Ice Center reserves the right to allow additional disciplines on designated sessions.

RIGHT OF WAY

1. **Programs have priority to the right of way.** The program skater should be easily identifiable by the use of a personal, visible colored sash tied around the waist. Programs should be played in the order they are lined up on the score table.
2. **Lessons have the second priority to the right of way.** Always yield the right of way to the skater/dance team wearing their sash/s and performing their program.

FLOW OF THE ICE

(Diagram represents general guidelines)

- Spins should be done in the center of the ice.
- The ends of the arena are for jumping and are considered the jump zones.

DISCLAIMER:

Diagram based on a full session. Guidelines are highly recommended regardless of the number of skaters on the session.

ETIQUETTE AND SAFETY

- Be courteous both on and off the ice. "Excuse me" or "Thank you" go a long way. Be considerate if you can see that another skater does not see you coming.
- If receiving instruction, stand against the boards out of the way of others.
- Keep your head up and be aware of other skaters around you.
- When passing slower skaters, try to pass to the outside of the skater.
- When you are not skating, please leave the ice.
- If you fall, get up right away. If you are hurt, stay still on the ice until staff reaches you.
- Do not stay in one place or stand around on the ice, you may be asked to exit the ice by staff if you do.
- Be on time for your sessions, especially after a resurface. Use every minute of your ice time to the maximum.
- Apologize when you accidentally get in someone else's way, especially if they had the right of way.
- For your safety, no one is allowed on the ice without skates or ice cleats. Ice cleats can be checked out at Skate Rental.
- Respect others space. Do not jump or skate too close to another skater or coach.
- Prior to entering the ice surface, skaters and coaches must sign-in and pay for sessions at the front desk.
- During a formal lesson, a skater/coach may bump their program music to the **next-in-line** program. Please wear your own personal sash when you are performing your program to your music.
- Skaters must be at least a **Learn to Skate USA Basic 4** level to participate on any figure skating session.
- Be professional. Do not sit on the boards or on the ice.



SESSION RULES

- Sertich Ice Center expects sportsmanship, respect, dignity, and courtesy on all figure skating sessions. Through responsible behavior and fair play, coaches, skaters, and parents will assume the role of good will ambassadors of figure skating.
- Sertich Ice Center will not tolerate any dishonest conduct, cheating, poor sportsmanship, criminal behavior, or any attempt to take unfair advantage of another in any activity.
- Sertich Ice Center does not allow parents to coach, instruct, or advise from any area in the facility or on the ice unless that parent provides a certificate of insurance and has made arrangements with Sertich management to coach their child.
- Sertich Ice Center does not allow anyone, including parents to stand in the hockey box areas during sessions. Only those skating or coaching during the ice session are permitted in the hockey boxes for the safety of the skaters.
- Sertich highly discourages the use of earbuds/headphones on the ice. Skaters should be able to hear their surroundings while on the ice with others.
- Sertich Ice Center does not tolerate ice kicking, profanities, or excessive waste of ice time. If any of these behaviors occur, management will request that the skater remove themselves from the ice.
- Sertich Ice Center does not allow group lessons of more than four (4) on figure skating sessions.
- Sertich Ice Center does not allow coaches or skaters to sit on the boards during figure skating sessions.
- Coaches and skaters are not permitted on the ice at any time during an ice resurface. Please exit the ice promptly. Ice resurfacer doors must be closed before any skater or coach may enter the ice surface.
- Sertich Ice Center prohibits any use or distribution of illegal substances. Sertich Ice Center can immediately dismiss skaters and coaches from the facility for this offense and no refund will be granted. Using or possessing alcoholic beverages while in the facility is not allowed.
- Sertich Ice Center prohibits any deliberate or reckless misuse, damage, or destruction of any property. Management can immediately dismiss skaters and coaches from the facility for this offense and will require full payment for damaged property.
- Skaters are responsible for filling any holes or gouges they create with slush from the slush bucket.
- Split sessions are not allowed.
- No food or drink on the ice except for water.
